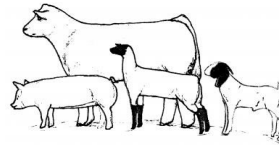

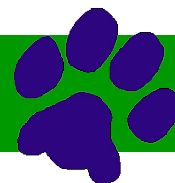

New year during our January meeting.

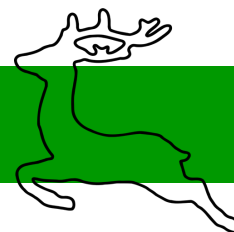
We will also have our Community Service

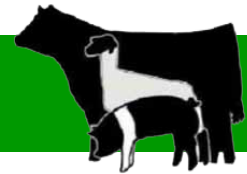

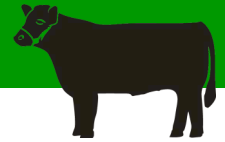

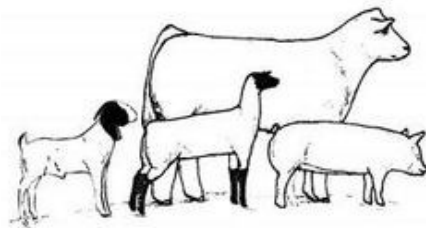
