4-H Grows Green with One Day 4-H

Carson County 4-H participated in a statewide One Day 4-H Community Service project on Saturday, October 10. To help celebrate 100 years of the Texas A&M Forest Service Carson County 4-H planted a commemorative Bur Oak tree on the south lawn of the Courthouse.

Billy Gage, of the Texas Forest Service, helped the 4-H'ers plant their tree as part of the educational experience. He also presented a program about the Texas Forest Service complete with a demonstration of the equipment and other interesting aspects of his Forest Service truck.

"It was fun to know we were joining with thousands of other 4-H'ers across the state to honor the Texas A&M Forest Service," said Ashby Dauer, President of the Panhandle Shining Stars 4-H Club. "We hope this tree can also serve as a symbol for how a community grows outstanding 4-H members."

Also in attendance at the event were County Judge, Dan Looten, County Commissioner, Mike Jennings, and Jody Bradford and Jeanene Montgomery of the Carson County AgriLife Extension Service, as well as several 4-H members from the county and their families.

For one hundred years the Texas A&M Forest Service has been providing leadership in protecting and sustaining the state's trees, forests and related natural resources. The first efforts of a few forest patrolmen on horseback in East Texas have grown into today's network of protection statewide. TFS makes Texas stronger by imparting land management practices to landowners, grants for training and equipment to fire departments, and information, tools and resources to communities.

The service project was the first statewide featured service project in the One Day 4-H service event's seven year history. 4-H members in attendance also received a Bur Oak seedling to plant in the location of their choice.

on Thursday January 21st !!


