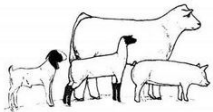
Carson County Junior Livestock Show

Quality Counts Training

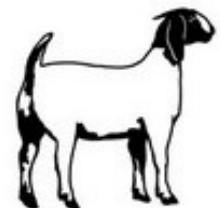
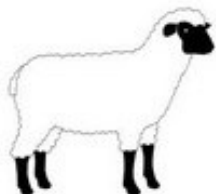
