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DISTRICT RECORD BOOK JUDGING



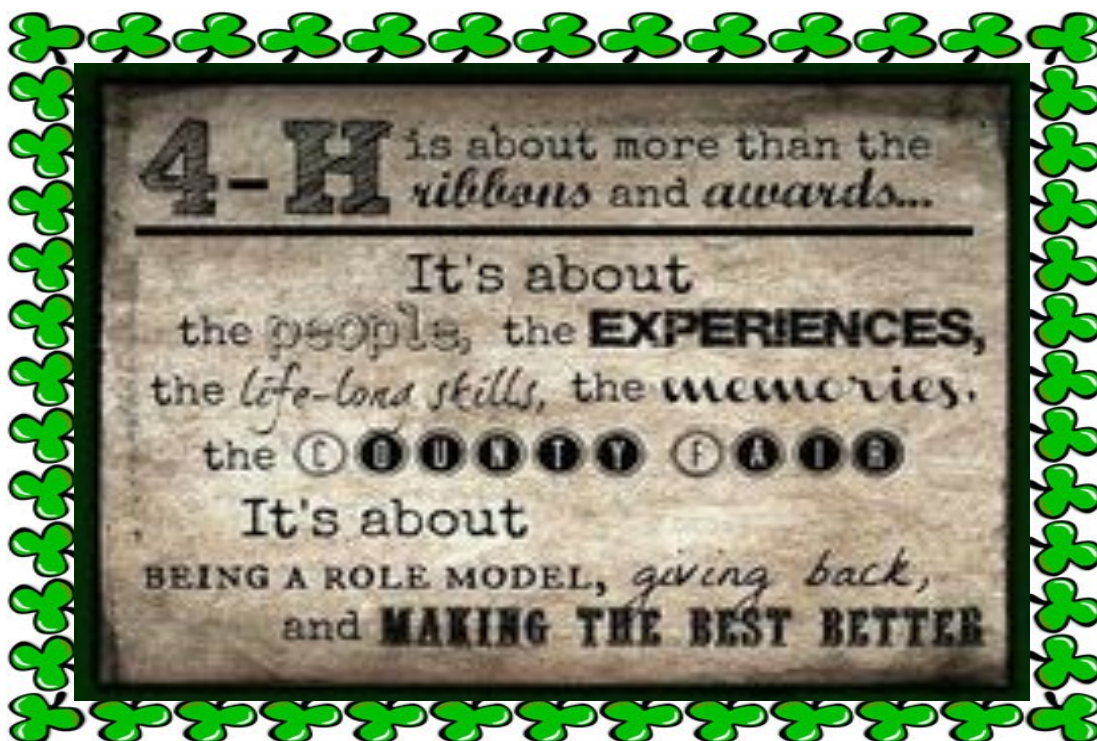
District Record Book Judging will be **July 10th**.

****Only recordbooks reviewed at the county level are allowed to move forward.****




