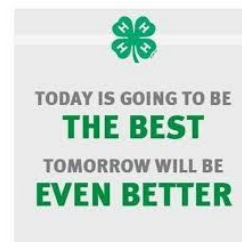
4-H MEMBERS TO COMPETE AT STATE

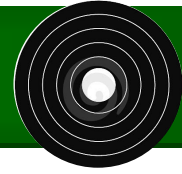

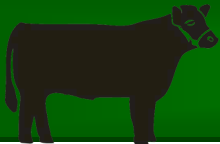


DISTRICT 1 ARCHERY

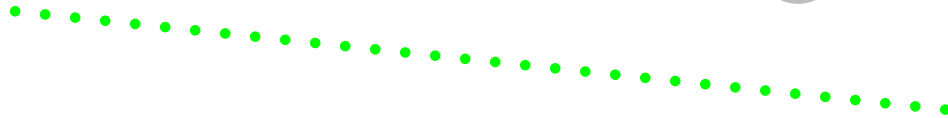
